You should take Die-cutting with Spellbinders 201 if:

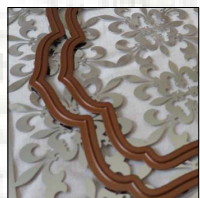
- You want to use your Spellbinders dies for more than just basic cutting.
