Pressed flowers Crafts By Corina Brouwers

You need to collect and press flowers, leaves, grasses & herbs. You can either do this with a homemade flower press, an old phonebook/yellow pages book or the microfleur.

If you love to work with dried flowers and don't have time to wait until they are ready to use I would suggest the microfleur. This microwave flower press will preserve all your flowers in just minutes. (And the colours of your dried flowers are awesome!)

Although you can probably buy the Microfleur on more sites or even in your local crafts store I would suggest buying them at [NorthWest Natureshop](#). They donate 20% of the profit to environmental, educational or community organisations...
