## Class Supply List:

Each week we'll explore several features of the Quickutz Silhouette Diecutting Machine. The basic supplies are listed below. Each week I'll also post shapes you will need to purchase for download and fonts we will be using. Please feel free to make substitutions.

## Supplies:

- Paper Trimmer
- A good supply of 8.5 x 11 cardstock or 1212 cardstock you can cut down to 8.5" wide.
- Quickutz Silhouette Machine with software and cables
- Quickutz Silhouette Blades with colored caps
- Quickutz Silhouette Mats
- Laptop or computer that is compatible with Windows Operating Systems (Silhouette does not work with Mac)
- Assortment of patterned papers
- Adhesive
- A Quickutz Spatula (a Cricut brand spatula will work just as well)
- Quickutz Silhouette Machine
- Quickutz Silhouette Mats
- Quickutz Silhouette Blades
- Laptop or Computer, with internet connection
- Script Style Font (French Script is a good one)
- Print + Cut Quickutz Silhouette shapes
- 1 sheet 8.5x11 white cardstock for printing
- Color Printer connected to the same laptop or computer as your Silhouette
- Photos
- Adhesive
- Trimmer
- Quickutz Sketch Markers
- Assortment of 12x12 cardstock and patterned papers for creating the scrapbook layouts
