

Metal Sampler with Kim Parkinson

Supply List

For this class you'll need an assortment of supplies. I use exclusively Ten Seconds Studios tools and metals but you can use similar tools made by Merc Art or other companies. I have broken down the supply list to include the "Name Brand" items I use as well as the "Substitution Items" I can recommend. Use whatever suits you. If you own some of the metal embossing tools but not others, mix and match. There are no hard fast rules as far as the supplies go. Although your results may differ from those with the tools used to work metal, I do encourage you to use what you have and buy what you can when you can.

Items needed for all classes:

Items marked with an * are from Ten Seconds Studio

Name Brand Items	Substitution Items
Acrylic Mat Set *	Glass Mat, Mouse pad
Paper Stump *	Paper Stump from Fine Art section of craft store
Aluminum Metal: Dark Chocolate, Art Metal and Pearl *	Many companies make colored metal but you can also do all these projects with just the top to a disposable aluminum party pan.
Basic Tool Kit *	Empty ball point pen or dull wooden skewer
Ball and cup tool *	Dry emboss stylus
Several assorted molds *	Any hard plastic mold will work. Fiskars and Sizzix make a few as well.
Humungo Adhesive*	Any Red line or just as strong adhesive
Cuttlebug with embossing folder	Any companies embossing folder and machine
Magenta Tree Stamp and Pear Stamp	Any stamp without words or numbers will work
Black, Pool, espresso colored dabbers from Ranger. Also Landscape Green paint by Ranger	Any black and turquoise paint. As well as any other colors you want for background canvas.
Brass stencil from Lasting Impressions	Any stencil, brass, metal, plastic

Brass brush *	Small brass brush from hardware store
Metal Tape Sheets *	Flashing tape from hardware store
Magenta Peel offs	Any brand peel offs
Ranger's Alcohol Inks	Any brand alcohol inks
Tattered Angels Glimmer Mist	Any brand mist or spray
Wheel tools *	A Pastry wheel or a clay wheel
